Ackton Pastures Primary Academy Mission Statement for children with Special Educational Needs and/or Disabilities (SEND)

The School is committed to a policy of educational inclusion whereby a supportive learning environment is provided. It is our aim for all children to have their diverse needs met, to experience success and develop a feeling of self-worth. All school staff are actively engaged in trying to match provision to the individual needs of all our pupils. We recognise that some children have significantly greater difficulty in learning or accessing the curriculum than others of their age. These difficulties may be long or short- term. These children are identified as having 'Special Educational Needs and/or Disability (SEND).'

The aim of the School is to maximise the learning and personal development of pupils recognised as having 'Special Educational Needs and/or Disability' through:

- Supporting children with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities to access mainstream education in an inclusive environment whenever possible
- Working in partnership with families and outside agencies to ensure the best support is given to children with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities
- Supporting all staff who work with children with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities.
